'Jihad' means struggle or effort</p> <p>Some Muslims interpret 'Jihad' as a Holy War / military war</p> <p>Muslims may fight in self-defence but must not initiate a war</p> <p>5 rules / conditions of a just war</p> <p>Some people fight for Allah believing this means they are living a good life.</p>
