

KS2 SATs Please remember Year 6 SATs will take place the week beginning Monday 8th May. At the moment the children are working hard for the last few weeks before the tests. Please support them at home and ensure they have a quiet place to complete their homework. It is still important that they read every night, practice times tables and spellings. Also they need to go to bed at a reasonable hour so they can concentrate fully the next day.
