Instagram It has been brought to our notice that the terms and conditions of some internet sites need to be carefully checked before using them. We have been given specific information about Instagram which around half of 8-15 year olds use. Two of the clauses cause particular concern: **“Officially you own any original pictures and videos you post, but we are allowed to use them, and we can let others use them as well, anywhere around the world. Other people might pay us to use them and we will not pay you for that.”** **“We might send you adverts connected to your interests which we are monitoring. You cannot stop us doing this and it will not always be obvious that it is an advert.”**

Instagram's simplified Terms and Conditions can be found in the report: Growing Up Digital (Children's Commissioner 2017).
