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Need for vigilance We have witnessed that some of our children and families have been the victims of racism or threatening behaviour. This seems more of an issue recently. If you or your family are the subject of any of the crimes, including name calling, please report by calling the non police 101 to report, or speak to someone at school about it.

FGM For some women and young girls, this time of year signals increased risk from communities which practice female genital mutilation (FGM).

It is important to note that this is an illegal act according to UK law, even if this takes place abroad. If you have concerns that a girl is at risk of FGM or suspect that she may already have undergone FGM, contact Nottingham children and families direct on 0115 876 4800. For all cases where it is known that FGM has taken place you must call the police on 101 under the mandatory duty to report. We would appreciate your support with this matter.
