Absences

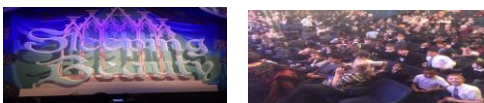
It is part of our policy that if your child is going to be absent from school, you must inform the school office each day of their absence. If your child has vomited they must not return to school for 48 hrs after being sick.
