

OUR VISIT TO ST PAULS CHURCH IN LENTON NOVEMBER 2015

There will be statue of her in every Catholic church.




This is a '

Catholics will go to church to ask forgiveness from the priest for things they have done wrong.




Then they pray to the Madonna and light a candle.

This is the font where babies are christened and welcomed into the church




When Catholics go into the church they make a sign of the cross with the 'Holy' water
