This is a 'Confessional Box'. Catholics will go to church to ask forgiveness from the priest for things they have done wrong.



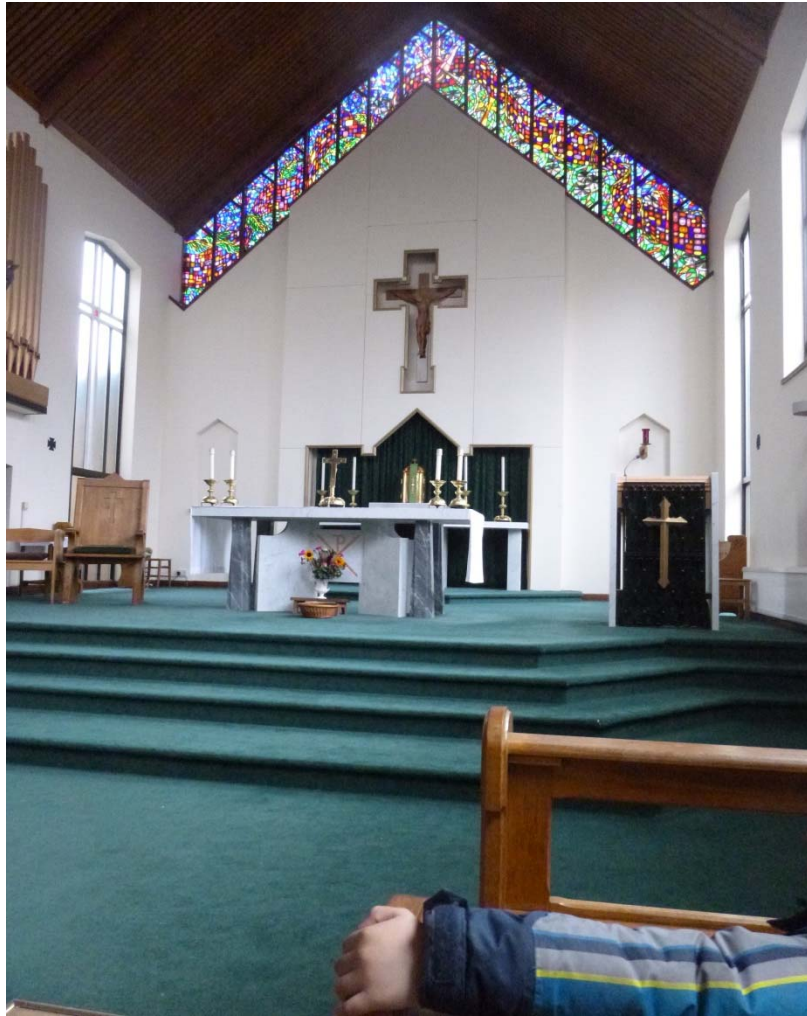
**Then they pray
