

We all went to the Synagogue in Nottingham to learn more about Judaism and to look around the Synagogue





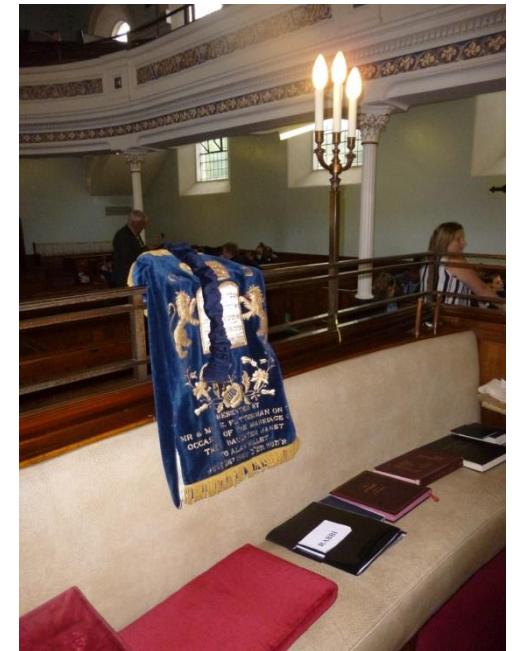
Rabbi Perez showed us around and talked to everyone about the beginnings of Judaism.
