

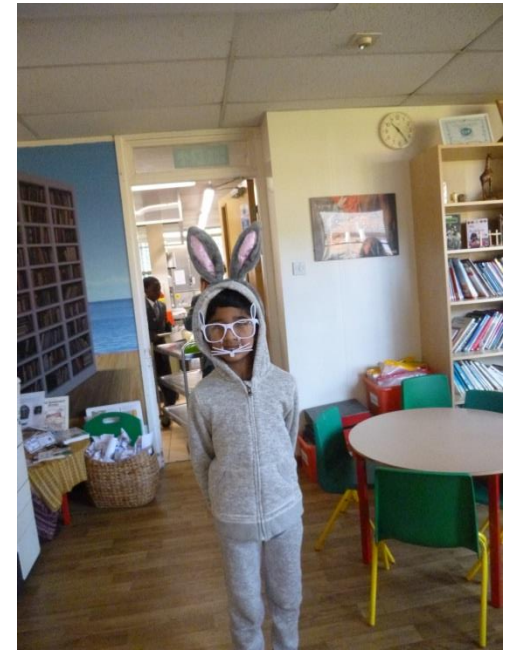

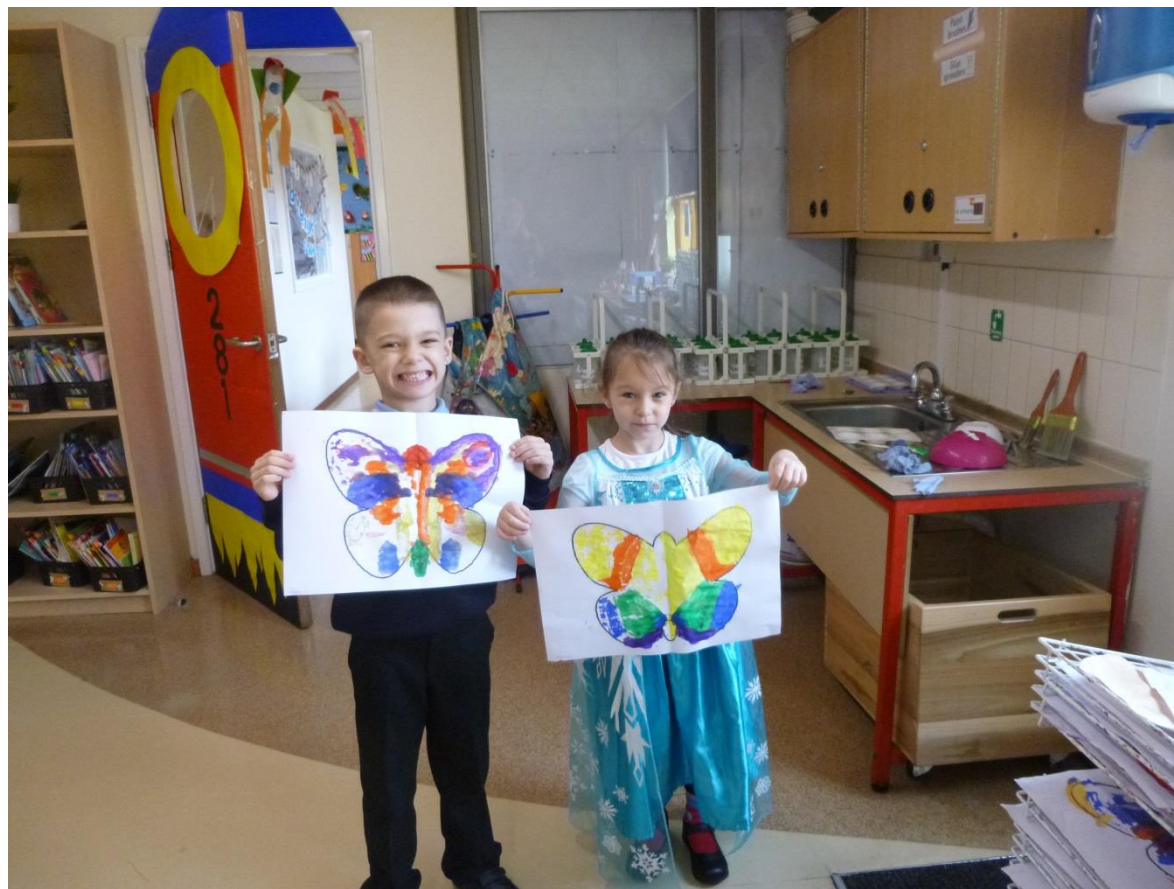
Staff dressed up too!

Year 3 read Folk Stories from the Rain Forest and sketched the animals



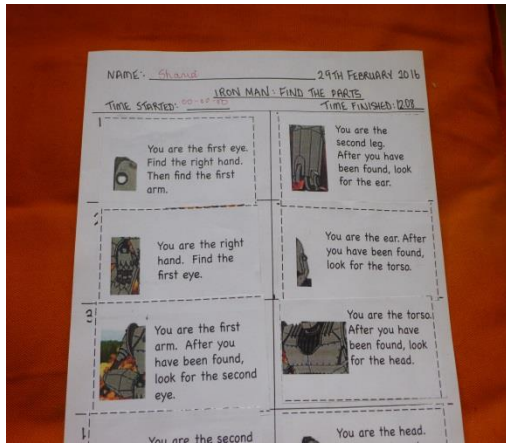
The 'Great Paper Chase' was the book for Year 4 and they did some drawing, sketching and painting about the book
