Dear Parent/ Carer,

This newsletter will give you some general information about class 1 but please do ask if you have any questions. The adults in class 1 this year will be Miss Lewis and Miss Loach.

P.E

Please make sure that your child has their full P.E kit in school all week. P.E kits **must** be a white t-shirt, black shorts and either plimsolls or trainers. Class 1 has PE on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.

Water Bottles

Your child will need to bring a labelled water bottle into school for the week. These will be returned home every Friday to be washed.

Inhalers.

If your child has asthma and needs an inhaler could you please bring an inhaler labelled with your child's name into school for us to keep in the classroom.

Homework

Each term your child will be set 5 pieces of homework which is related to their topic. It is expected that your child completes one piece of topic homework each week and returns their homework book every week. All pieces of topic homework need to be completed by the last Wednesday of each half term.

In addition to topic homework your child will receive spellings and maths which they will be tested on in school the following week.

Homework will be set on a Wednesday to be returned the following Wednesday. Any homework not completed will result in your child staying in at break times to complete it.

Reading with your child.

Please read with your child every day and record this in their reading diary. Their diary will be checked and signed once a week by the class teacher.

If there are any questions or concerns please don't hesitate to talk to any of the adults in Class 1. I will be available to talk to on the playground each morning. If you would like to meet with me then please leave a message with the office and I will contact you to arrange a suitable time.
