<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Sticky Knowledge</p>	<p>5 pillars of Islam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • prayer • fasting • charity • Hajj (pilgrimage) • Shahada <p>(declaration of the belief that there is only 1 God and Mohamed is His Prophet)</p>	<p>Ways to celebrate Christmas</p> <p>Jesus was God 'incarnate'</p> <p>He taught people how to live a good life, performed miracles, offered forgiveness of sins, through his death and resurrection he would grant all humanity a fresh start</p> <p>Know which traditions are centred around a Christian belief.</p>	<p>What is eternity?</p> <p>What is unconditional love?</p> <p>Know that Jesus taught that love should be eternal and unconditional.</p> <p>Christians believe that for eternal life they need to believe in God, follow the 10 Commandments, ask for forgiveness for their sins.</p> <p>Know that many religions believe that some things are eternal e.g. God, the soul, Brahman etc.</p>	<p>Christian festivals & their respective symbols.</p> <p>Christian charities and the work they do.</p> <p>Some countries persecute / torture / imprison Christians – is this because Christianity is a strong religion?</p> <p>Christian influences in British society i.e. 'God save the Queen', taking oath and swearing on the bible.</p> <p>Numbers of followers for each religion.</p> <p>Arguments against Christianity being a strong religion ie. some churches are turned over to different uses.</p>	<p>'Good' actions can be interpreted differently, not everyone agrees on what is 'good'. Know what Muslims do in order to lead a good life.</p> <p>Muslims believe that Allah will judge them when they die and the good will be weighed against the bad.</p> <p>Know that Muslims believe in the afterlife (Aakhirah)</p> <p>Spiritual struggle or effort to follow the teachings of Allah is called 'Greater Jihad'. 'Jihad' means struggle or effort</p> <p>Some Muslims interpret 'Jihad' as a Holy War / military war</p> <p>Muslims may fight in self-defence but must not initiate a war</p> <p>5 rules / conditions of a just war</p> <p>Some people fight for Allah believing this means they are living a good life.</p>
